

Further remarks... For additional online formats, I would like...

It would be nice if the lecturer provided more examples. It was more about discussing the concepts of "interdisciplinary", which was rather boring. Also, the lecturer let us be open to discuss whatever we want, which is good, but he did not give any comment or feedback.

Nothing to add: loved the course structure, group work, trainer's motivation and knowledge, handouts... all in all, glad I participated.

I would like future online courses to be broken down into smaller modules. It would be better if the courses were split into three-hour sessions spread over multiple days. The time frame of this online course was a little overwhelming.

I think for online formats it's particularly important to have a clear structure, a schedule etc. A handout with time schedule, summarized content, collection of material, examples etc. would be helpful. I'm skeptical of the format "here is a topic and some sources, go research it then present it to your fellows" especially if the time to research the topic thoroughly is limited. I think it takes more time and experience with the topic to summarize the content, structure it, condense it and be able to convey it. For me the content was too theoretical, I would have liked more practical examples/applications. The breakout sessions would be a good opportunity for discussions in small circles with the lecturer.

An introduction lecture about the course specifics. A few more slides explaining theoretical knowledge and practical application.

Interpersonal communications, dealing with different conflict situations, navigating oneself in academia (perhaps coping with the change from practice to academia), resilience, small talk and networking
