

Further remarks... For additional online formats, I would like...

There was a lot of repetitions in some parts of the course, especially exercises. I hope it is avoided in the future. The number of exercises was too much, and need more focusing to achieve them, which limited the benefiting of this course.

The lecturer was already quite prepared for the online format.

Not to use Zoom. Zoom as a platform has had a lot of negative press in recent months, and I was really not comfortable with using it. While WebEx is not perfect either, it is the platform the university has chosen to use (and no huge scandals associated with it). I would rather have used WebEx.

Remarks: I think the course could be improved at some point, including some more examples (do's and don'ts) even if there are persons from different fields. There are some topics that everybody understands. To call it roadmap I expected not to only talk about the writing process but also how to coordinate work and writing. Online Formats: I would prefer to use one tool for all courses e.g. webex teams.
